Although many people think of idolatry as a primitive practice of ancient cultures or third-world tribes, it's as big an issue in today's Western world as it has ever been. In fact, one could argue that the idolatry we practice in the United States is more shameful and dangerous than bowing down to carved images because we don't even realize we're guilty of it. In this study participants will identify many present-day idols and be equipped by God's Word to avoid falsely worshiping them.
